Room Consolidation

In an effort to give everyone the opportunity to live with a roommate as well as make sure our rooms are at full occupancy, once the room change process is complete we will begin the room consolidation process. For all students, this means if you are currently in a double room by yourself, in a triple room with two people, etc. al, we will be looking into moving you in with someone or having someone move in with you. If you are part of this group, you will receive an e-mail within the next few weeks letting you know the process has started! *NOTE:* our goal is to keep you on the same floor in the same building you are currently in, unless you have a preference of moving elsewhere.

Be an RA at Valpo!

Applications for Resident Assistant positions in the Spring 2012 semester will be available on Friday, October 7! Applicants must have at least a 2.3 GPA, attained at least sophomore status by the end of the Fall 2011 semester (24 credits or more), and have lived on campus at Valparaiso University for at least one semester. Applications can be found on Residential Life website (www.valpo.edu/reslife). They must be submitted by 5pm on Friday, October 28, 2011.

Fix My Room

If there is a maintenance issue in your room you can go online and place a work request! Room Condition Report (RCR)

When you checked in this year, a Resident Assistant went through your RCR with you to note the condition of your room at your time of move in. At the end of the year, if something from that report has changed (for example, a chair is missing, marks are left on the wall, and so on), our department assesses this and may charge you. To be proactive about this, we recommend the following:

- Do not remove any furniture from your rooms at any time! This is not only a policy but very important to help you avoid fines and fees at the end of the year. This includes putting furniture in lounges and hallways.
- Do not hang anything up with materials that would tear the paint off your wall. Some tapes and adhesives will do this.
- If you have a question about anything in your room or something was not recorded on your Room Condition Report, **ask your RLC!** Do not wait until after closing!

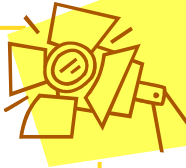
